

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Notice: Wiring must comply with local and national electrical codes.

FLUIDS:

Valves are intended for water, air, light oil, and other noncorrosive fluids. They should <u>not</u> be used for gasoline and other hazardous or explosive fluids. Maximum fluid temperature is 200° F (93.3°C). Ambient temperature shall not exceed 120°F (48.8°C).



WARNING: NOT FOR USE WITH HAZARDOUS OR CORROSIVE OR EXPLOSIVE FLUIDS.

A. INSTALLATION:

Model 478PS has a stainless steel body with 1" NPT thread connections. The valve may be mounted in any position other than with the coil lower than the body. It is available with either a 120VAC, 24VAC 60Hz coil, or 230 VAC 50 Hz coil. The coil can rotationally be oriented in any convenient direction.

B. OPERATION:

When the solenoid coil is energized, a plunger is pulled away from a pilot port thus relieving the pressure on top of the diaphragm and allowing input pressure from underneath to push the diaphragm up and open the outlet port.

D. TROUBLE SHOOTING:

CAUTION: TURN OFF WATER SUPPLY & ELECTRICITY BEFORE SERVICING.

Failure to open:

- 1) No power or low voltage.
- 2) Coil burnout (overvoltage) or an open circuit to coil connections.
- 3) Dirt, scale or sludge may prevent the plunger from operating.
- 4) Pressure differential exceeds the MOPD rating of the valve.

Failure to close:

- 1) Coil still energized.
- 2) Pressure in the outlet or valve installed backward.
- 3) Dirt deposits on valve seat or enclosing tube keeping plunger from closing.
- 4) O-Ring beneath valve seat may be missing.

Water-hammer:

1) Quick acting valves may cause water-hammer when operated. If this occurs, it may be minimized by the use of a standpipe or other commercially available shock absorber installed near the valve inlet.

CAUTION: WHEN SERVICING UNIT BE SURE THAT REPLACEMENT PARTS HAVE BEEN INSTALLED ACCORDING TO FIGURE 1.

RETURNS:



OVERALL DIMENSIONS



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
